Neuroscientist & Entrepreneur

The only constant in life is change. And the only way to thrive in a rapidly changing world is to change with it. We know that. But the biggest barrier is in our heads. Beau Lotto is a world-renowned expert in the neuroscience of perception. He reveals why trading certainty for doubt increases our capacity to adapt, lead, innovate, and thrive in the darkness of "I don't know".

A professor at University of London, as well as a visiting scholar at New York University, he is a three-time mainstage TED speaker with over 10 million views. Beau's latest book is Deviate: The Science of Seeing Differently.

Beau says, "Once you understand how perception works, you can't help but see yourself in the world in a different way and engage in it in a different way".
